Key Facts

We have noted some key facts around participation and remuneration for those who choose to opt-in and offer the distribution of LFD kits to members of the public detailed in the circular to support with the delivery of the service.

- If you wish to offer the service you can opt-in by completing [Annex B](#), which is downloadable from above. This should be completed for each contractor code and sent to nss.psd-sgforms@nhs.scot. By annotating in the subject field of the email 'LFD Form' this will allow for timely turnaround of payments.
- If you wish to withdraw from the service at any given time, please complete the withdrawal form in [Annex B](#) and send to nss.psd-sgforms@nhs.scot.
- A participation fee of £450 is available for those who opt-in and covers initial set-up costs including creating an SOP for the service, training of team members, and storage costs.
- Kits are available from Alliance Healthcare using the pip code 8031338. Kits are also available from Sigma Pharmaceuticals, Phoenix Healthcare are supply solely to Rowlands Pharmacy
- Test kits are supplied in cartons containing 54 boxes. Each box is for an individual person containing 7 test kits. Tests are to be self-administered by the public away from the pharmacy. The pharmacy is only responsible for the supply of the kits and providing the appropriate information to the person collecting.
- On receipt of each carton from wholesalers please record the lot number, supplying wholesaler and date of receipt in support of any product recall required. A log for this is available in [Annex C](#).
- To claim for a supply of LFD kits, use the UCF Covid-19 LFD Supply service, selecting the Lateral Flow Device Kit and enter the quantity of boxes. You will then select the dispensed item of Lateral Flow Device Kit (7 tests) and the quantity of boxes dispensed.



Key Facts

- For all claims, the batch number is to be recorded in the 'Supporting Document Reference' and attached to the electronic claim. For claims where you do not have the person's CHI number, their contact details (e.g. phone number) should be recorded in the 'Supporting Document Reference' along with the batch number before you submit the claim.
- If there is a supply to a household of 4 people for example this would be recorded as 4 kits and remunerated accordingly.
- A distribution fee of £2.00 per kit will be paid.
- Payments for participation will be annotated as LFDPart in the eSchedules and LFDCollect for distribution fees.
